Are you a UK taxpayer?

If you are a UK taxpayer and Gift Aid your donation, we will be able to receive an additional 28p. We can claim Gift Aid tax relief of 25p on every £1 you give and HMRC will also be operating transitional provisions for Gift Aid donations made from 6 April 2008 until 5 April 2011, paying a Government supplement of 3p on every £1 you give.

Notes:

1. To qualify for Gift Aid, what you pay in income tax or capital gains tax must at least equal the amount that Making Music will reclaim on the donation.

2. If your circumstances change and you no longer pay enough income or capital gains tax to cover the amount claimed by the charity, you can cancel your declaration.
3. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief via your Self Assessment tax return (currently 25p for each pound you give. Higher rate taxpayers can claim back the difference between basic rate and higher rate tax.)
