Born in Belgium in 1982, the viola player Dimitri Murrath is a former pupil of Natalia Boyarsky at the Yehudi Menuhin School. He currently studies at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama (London) with David Takeno.

He is a laureate of the Tenuto Competition (Belgian Television) and has won awards from the Hattori Foundation, Musicians Benevolent Fund, Martin Musical Scholarship Fund and the Belgian Foundation for Young Soloists. Recent performances have included debut recitals at the Palais des Beaux-Arts (Brussels), Royal Festival Hall, and other solo and chamber music performances in Wigmore Hall and Purcell Room.

Concerto appearances include performances with the London Mozart Players, the Flemish Radio Orchestra and with the Yehudi Menuhin School Orchestra at the Menuhin Festival in Gstaad. He recently performed in Carnegie Hall as part of a workshop given by the Emerson String Quartet. Other chamber music programs include IMS Prussia Cove and Ravinia's Steans Institute for Young Artists (Chicago).
