- for your contact details, so we can get in touch if we would like to meet you for an interview, but these will be separated from the rest of your application
- to complete three tasks/questions. Your answers to these are used to create a longlist.

If you are on the longlist, we will ask you:

- to complete a second form with your education and employment or volunteer experience
- to answer one further question about whether you have experienced barriers to opportunities in the past due to a protected characteristic or your socio-economic background. If you have, and we have to decide between candidates of equal merit for interview, we will take positive action to include you on the final interview shortlist.

Timeline

- Please complete the application form no later than **9.00am on Monday 21st July 2025**.
- We will contact you by **5.00pm on Tuesday 22nd July** if you are longlisted and we would like you to submit the second stage of information.
- Deadline for submission of second form – **9.00am Monday 28th July**.
- We will notify you by **5.00pm on Monday 28th July** if we would like to interview you.
- **Thursday 31st July** - Interviews will be in person in our office in London (near Moorgate).

We will pay your travel expenses to come to interview. If we ask you to interview, let us know if the time of your interview is important e.g. so you can travel in one day.
