## **Fantasy of the Dawn revision of Ukulele Fantasy for string orchestra 2017**

*Fantasy of the Dawn* is a revision for string orchestra of the original piece *Ukulele Fantasy*.

*Ukulele Fantasy* was developed for The Lincoln Ukulele Band as part of 2015-16 Adopt a Composer Scheme, funded by PRS for Music Foundation and the Philip and Dorothy Green Music Trust, and run by Making Music, in partnership with Sound and Music and BBC Radio 3.

In its original form, the piece begins with a section that explores the unusual sounds that the Ukulele can make, conjuring up imagery of nortunal activity. In this new version the same types of sounds are explored but using the strengths and unique timbres of bowed string instruments. This builds to a dramatic point of climax, marking the beginning of an energetic rhythmic section that represents the emergence of the day and the energy that it brings.

duration: c. 6 mins

Optional extensions: doubling time values of graphic score section and/or repeating full notated section from rehearsal mark A.

Full extended version: 12 minutes

### **Graphic score - performance notes**

- 1) Divide the three parts between the ensemble trying to achieve an even balance between violins, violas, cellos and doubles basses as much as possible.
- 2) One violin player from each part at times indicated by \* are to then play the boxed material before return to their original part at the second \*.


The boxed material should be played with rhythmic freedom. The player should alternate between the boxes freely and can play them either arco or pizzacato, or move between the two within the same box.

- 3) Sul ponticello and sul tasto are abbreviated to S.P. and S.T. respectively. Normal playing position is reinstated by indication of 'nat.'.
- 4) . -> : gradually move from one technique/position to another.
- 5) Once the graphic score section is complete go immediately onto the notated material with as little gap as possible.

One violin player from each part move to boxed material at \* and then returns to part at second \*
