## **Jane Burnell, Soprano**

Jane was the Coro Nuovo Sussex Young Musician of the Year 2021 and a finalist in the 2022 Joyce and Michael Kennedy Award for the Singing of Strauss at the Royal Northern College of Music. Jane is currently studying for a Masters at RNCM having achieved a first class degree from Leeds Conservatoire. A regular concert soloist, in 2021 she performed for The Great Yorkshire Proms alongside Sir Willard White and Aled Jones MBE.



## **Christian Barraclough, Trumpet**

Christian graduated from the Royal College of Music with the Tagore Gold Medal and Brass Prizes. He works with many ensembles: BBC, Royal Philharmonic and Royal Scottish orchestras, English National Ballet and Opera, and London and Onyx Brass. Principal trumpet in major concert halls around the world, Christian can also be heard on many film soundtracks and video games.



## **James Edgeler, Tenor**

James is a graduate & choral scholar of Royal Holloway, London. He has participated in BBC R3 broadcasts, CD recordings and is an alumnus of The Sixteen's choral training programme. James gave his recital debut in Brighton, singing Quilter, Bridge and Vaughan Williams. Oratorio soloist performances include Mozart's Requiem, Haydn's Nelson Mass and Creation, Handel's Messiah and Bach's St John Passion.



## **Ian le Grice, Organ**

Organist and composer Ian le Grice was a junior exhibitioner at the Royal College of Music and a chorister at the Temple Church, London where he became assistant organist. Ian was musical associate of the English Arts Chorale for many years and their regular rehearsal accompanist. He accompanies St Cecilia Chorus, Croydon Philharmonic Choir and Reigate St Mary's School Choir.



## **Leslie Olive, Conductor**

Conductor, composer, educator, festival director and musical visionary, Leslie founded the English Arts Chorale and Orchestra in 1980. A passionate advocate for the power of music in people's lives, his choirs have covered the spectrum from professional choirs for the BBC to his 80-strong boys choir which has sung with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra and toured Europe.
